The delicate woodland Hydrangeas of Japan, AKISHINO TEMARI and BENI-GAKU, the elegant climbing Hydrangea relative SCHIZOPHRAGMA 'MOONLIGHT', and the exquisitely variegated HYDRANGEA 'QUADRICOLOR', each will grace a special spot in your shady garden corner.

Agapanthus, Cannas, Kniphofia and More

Vintage Perennials are always a rare lot, and though we grow fewer than we once did, every one we propagate is unusual, and all of them are great garden plants.

AGAPANTHUS may be common in California but the best cultivars are hard to find. Our favorites include the old DOUBLE AGAPANTHUS, the dwarf, deep cobalt BRESSINGHAM BLUE, Phillip Robinson's own heavy blooming deciduous, MORNING SKIES, and WINTER DWARF, a diminutive evergreen with excellent reliable bloom, superior to PETER PAN.

KNIPHOFIAS, the Poker plants so familiar in the waysides of Northern California, come in a range of subtle as well as brilliant hues. Luther Burbank's TOWER OF GOLD is an elegant, long-blooming plant with 6 foot spikes of clear yellow.
